General Notes:

1. The Principal of the institution shall carry out the admissions for these seats in the following manner.
 - a) Admissions shall be made in a transparent manner and strictly as per the Inter-Se-Merit of the Candidates who have applied to the Competent Authority for verification of documents and then to the Institution.
 - b) Information brochure of the Institution which specifies rules of admission should be available in the office. The cost of Application form is Rs. 200. All the information in the brochures should also be displayed on the Institution's website.
 - c) If any CAP seat remains or becomes vacant after the CAP Rounds, then the same shall be filled in by the Candidate from the same Category for which it was earmarked during the CAP. Further if the seats remain vacant then the seats shall be filled on the basis of Inter-Se Merit of the applicants.
 - d) Admission process will be carried out as per rules and regulations prescribed by the competent authority.
